Dear Safety Ambassador:

Thank you for taking time to administer the Safe-T-Riders© program. The Foundation believes by teaching young children the safe riding rules on elevators, escalators and moving walks we can help prevent unnecessary accidents. Below are step by step instructions for conducting the presentation.

PRIOR TO PRESENTATION:

PRESENTATION:

- Pre-video discussion of program (what are elevators, escalators, moving walks and where they can be found)
- Show [Safe T Rider Video](#) (3 1/2 Minutes)
- Go over safety rules for elevators, escalators and moving walkways.

ELEVATOR AND ESCALATOR RULES

Elevators

- 1) Watch your step
- 2) Leave closing doors alone
- 3) If doors don't open ring alarm button and wait
- 4) If there is a fire in the building use stairs

Escalators & Moving Walks

- 1) Step on and off carefully
- 2) People only – NO strollers, carts, animals, luggage
- 3) Hold the handrail
- 4) Take care of younger children, never leave unattended
- 5) Do not touch the sides below the handrail
- 6) Stand facing forward.

- Verbally quiz kids in a fun way; asking them questions about riding safely. Engage them and encourage answers when they raise their hands.
 - Sample Question: Should you hold the handrail on an escalator or not? Make these simple.
- Give children the [activity sheets](#), [certificates](#) and [Safety Rider coloring cut-outs](#).
- Congratulate them on learning how to ride elevators, escalators and moving walkways safely and becoming Safe-T-Riders themselves!





WRITE A SAFE-T-RIDER RULE YOU'VE LEARNED BELOW:


STAY SAFE ON MOVING SIDEWALKS

1. FACE STRAIGHT AHEAD.
2. STAND TO THE RIGHT.
3. DON'T TOUCH THE SIDES.
4. HOLD ONTO THE RAIL.

CONNECT THE DOTS AND SEE WHAT'S MOVING SAFE-T RIDERS!




FOLLOW THESE TIPS AND RIDE WITH NO WORRIES!



SAFE-T-RIDERS RIDE SAFELY

1. WATCH YOUR STEP WHEN GETTING ON AND OFF THE ELEVATOR.
2. IF THE ELEVATOR STOPS AND THE DOORS DON'T OPEN, PUSH THE ALARM BUTTON AND WAIT FOR SAFETY TO ARRIVE.
3. IN CASE OF A FIRE, SKIP THE ELEVATOR AND USE THE STAIRS.


Step 1. Using crayons, markers or colored pencils customize any of the items shown in this activity packet.

Step 2. Cut your customized character images out using a scissors.



